

# What is the UF VPN Client, and How Do I Use it? (For Windows XP/7/ 8/10 Users).

## What is the UF VPN Client and why do I have to use it?

Materials available electronically (journal articles, e-books, streaming video) are licensed for use by UF students, faculty and staff, and are easily accessible from any on-campus network.

The UF VPN Client allows UF students, faculty and staff to “tunnel” into the UF network from any off-campus network, and access these resources.

## How Do I Install the UF VPN Client?

- Go to this link: <https://net-services.ufl.edu/provided-services/vpn/clients/>
- Log in with your Gatorlink account information.
- Click on the link for the Windows software, as shown.

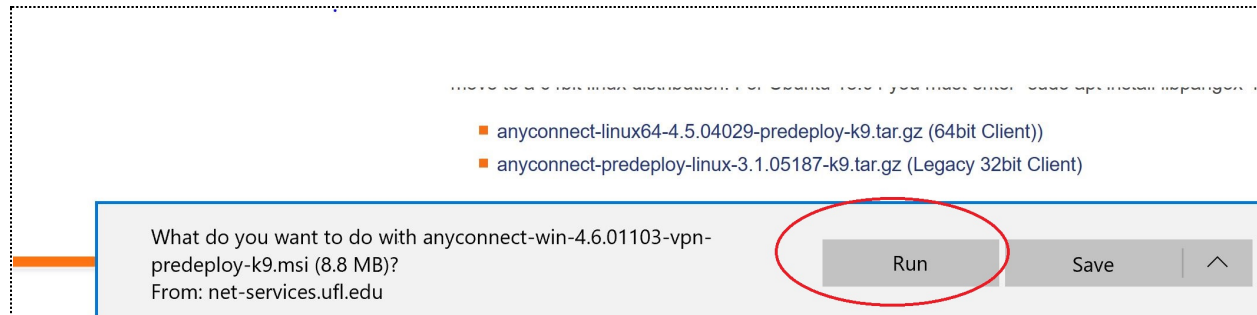

This client will be automatically updated to the latest officially supported version when the first connection is made. The installation guide can be found on the UF IT Wiki. Please remember that once the VPN client is installed via this page, you must type "vpn.ufl.edu" in the "Connect To" dialog.

Download and install the files in the order shown. Windows will ask if you want to run or save the files; choose Run (see below).



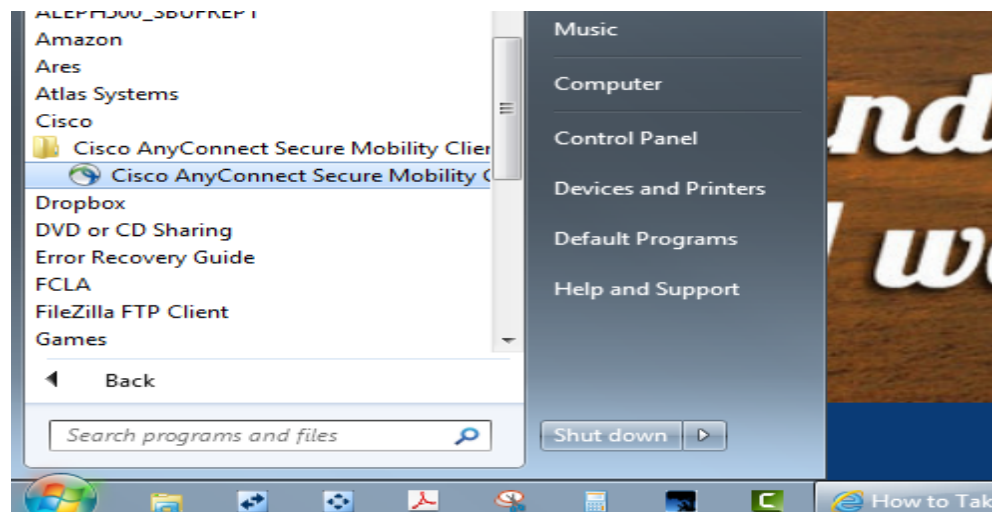
- Follow the onscreen instructions to complete the installation of the software. Restart your computer when prompted.

## How Do I Open and Configure the VPN Software?

To open the software:

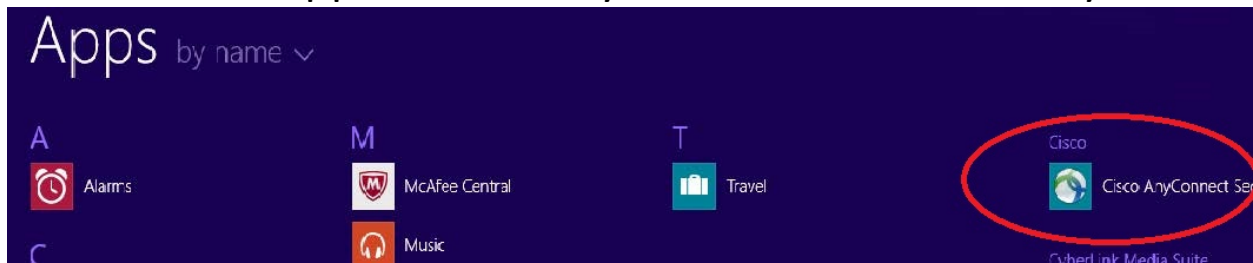
### Windows XP/7

Go to Start → All Programs → Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client.



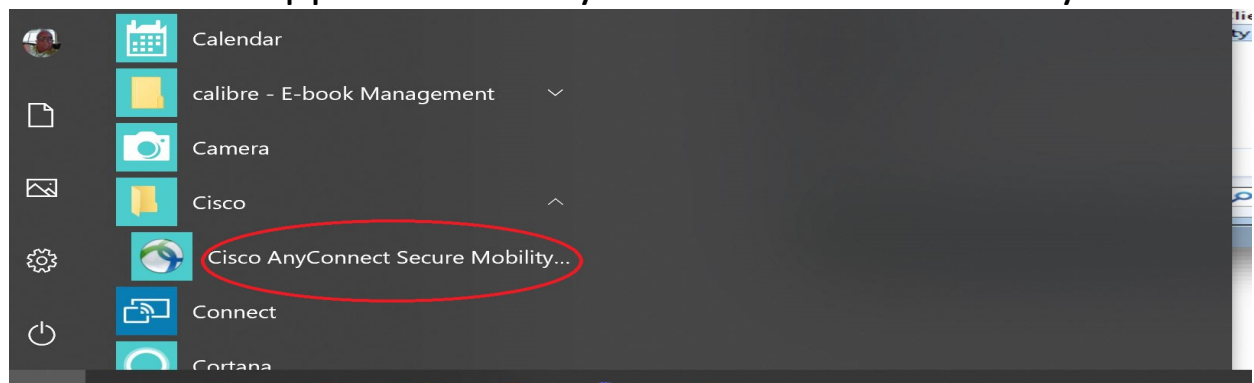
## Windows 8

Go to Start → Apps → Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client.

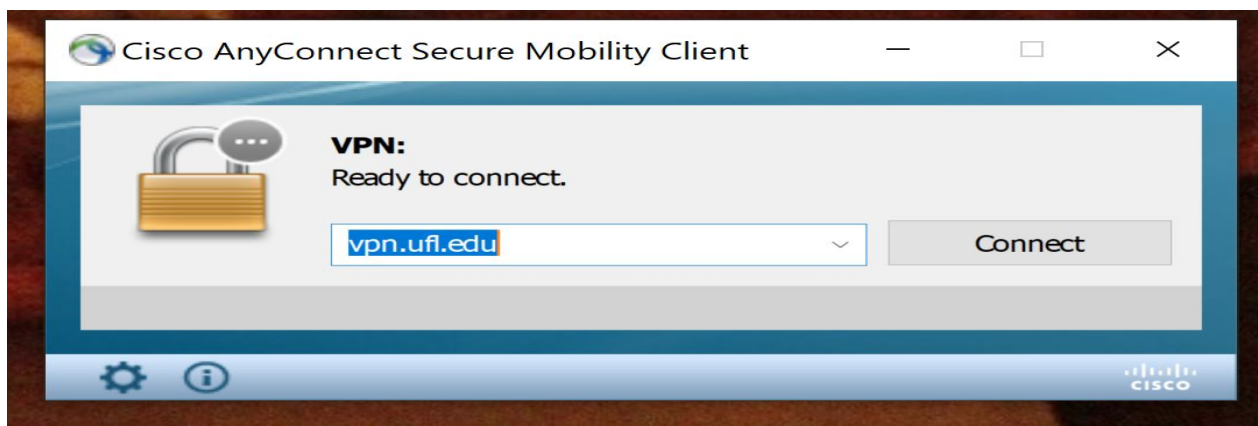


## Windows 10

Go to Start → Apps → Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client.



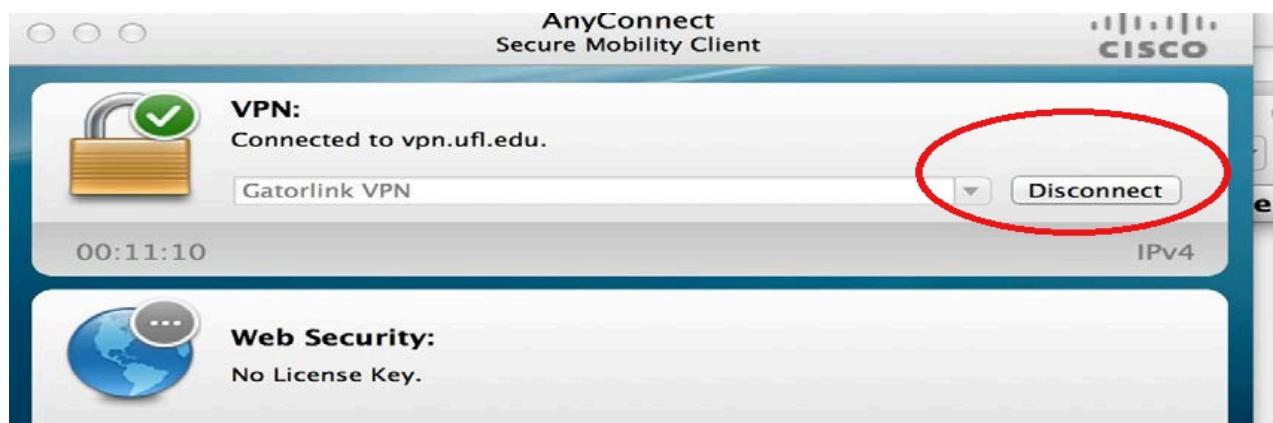
- A window will open. Type in `vpn.ufl.edu` (all lower-case letters) as shown below.



- Click on the connect button. A popup box will open. Enter your Gatorlink User ID and Password, then click on OK to log onto the VPN client.



- You are now connected to the UF VPN client and can access electronic course reserve items and UF Libraries electronic resources.
- To disconnect from the VPN client when you are finished, click on the Disconnect button, as shown below.
